

## SOME USEFUL ADVERBS IN FRENCH

**Goal:** By the end of this lesson, you should be able to attach an adverb of *lieu* to a verb when answering *où* questions.

It's one thing to know how to ask questions in French; it's another thing to be able to answer them correctly. And now that we've learned how to form questions with the interrogative pronouns *où*, *quand*, *comment*, I think it will be very helpful for the *frenchtastic* people of this group to learn some very useful French adverbs of *place*, *time*, and *manner*.

Depending on their meanings, adverbs can generally be classified in 7 categories. But here, we will study only 3 of them: the most common adverbs of *lieu* (place), *temps* (time), and *manière* (manner) in French. **Today's lesson will be about adverbs of *lieu* only.**

**Important:** This list of adverbs I am about to provide is not exclusive. These are just adverbs you are more likely to use or hear daily.
